
**M.Sc.(Analytical Chemistry)
(Academic Year 2023-2024)
Admission Notice**

- The merit list of the candidates (General and Reservation) for provisional admission to M.Sc.(Analytical Chemistry) on the basis of the Entrance Examination-2023 is available on the website of college.
- The admission to M.Sc. (Analytical Chemistry Part-I) Class for the academic year 2023-2024 will be given strictly on the basis of the merit of entrance examination and rules of reservation.
- Admissions will be confirmed / finalized on the basis of the entrance performance of candidates, category wise available seats as per the reservation norms and as per the eligibility criteria of SPPU. The eligibility criteria for M.Sc. (Analytical Chemistry) is as below:
- **Eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Chemistry as per SPPU Circular No. 205 of 2021**
 - a) B.Sc. degree with Chemistry as principal subject
 - b) B.Sc. (Blended) is eligible for M.Sc. Biochemistry
 - c) B.Sc. Nanoscience and Nanotechnology, B.pharm. Students are eligible for M.Sc. Biochemistry. If seats are available, admission shall be given to the students who have passed B.Sc. Botany, Zoology, Microbiology and Biotechnology.
- Counseling session for the M.Sc. (Analytical Chemistry Part I) is schedule on **2nd August, 2023** as per the following details:
- **Venue: Modern college of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous) Shivajinagar, Pune, New building, Late Lata Mangeshkar Sabhagruha, Time: 2.00 pm.**
- Candidates admitted in the counseling round will have to take and confirm admissions by filling online admission form and make the payment of fees from 2nd August 2023 to 5th August 2023.
- The candidates, who will not be present for the counseling round, will not have any claim on the admission.



| Sr. No | Percentage of fees refundable | Duration from the date of admission and date of submission of cancellation form request |
|--------|-------------------------------|--|

| 2 | 90% | After 10 days and before 15 days from the date of admission taken by the concerned student |
