Ambedkar's autobiography is used as a textbook in the Columbia University. Babasaheb Ambedkar fought for three years to get the comprehensive Hindu Code Bill passed which gave several important rights to women. In 1990, the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian award, was posthumously conferred upon Ambedkar. Dr.Ambedkar is the only Indian whose statue is attached to Karl Marx in the London Museum.

He also was a great orator and a musician who composed more than 3000 bhajans (spiritual poems) in Hindi and Marathi, having performed for the spiritual teacher Meher Baba in 1937 and 1944. He has also written many articles on Dharma, society, nation and education. He studied the existing reliaious sects and other schools of thought and discussed religious and secular problems of the devotees. He was determined to re-define socio-Spirituality and revitalise and awaken the nation. Saint Tukdoji Maharaj worked immensely for the Status of Women in Society. In 2005, the Nagpur University was renamed to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. Under the guidance of Respected Principal Dr. Rajendra S. Zunjarrao Sir, Librarian Dr. Shantashree Sengupta and Library Staff paid their respect to Sant Tukdoji Maharaj. All the rules of physical distancing were followed during the programme. As the chief minister of his kingdom, he introduced new public institutions such as the Anubhava Mantapa (or, the "hall of spiritual experience"), which welcomed men and women from all socio- economic backgrounds to discuss spiritual and mundane questions of life, in open. He is also known as **Bhaktibhandari** (literally, the treasurer of devotion), **Basavanna**. All the rules of physical distancing were followed during the programme. 


### 1.Sant Sevalal Maharaj Jayanti-15<sup>th</sup> February 2022

### 3.Sant Gadge Baba Jayanti and Sant Ravidas Maharaj Jayanti- 23rd February 2022

On 23rd February 2022, the Library and Information Centre of Progressive Education Society's Modern College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Shivajinagar, Pune -5 celebrated the Birth Anniversary of 'Sant Gadge Maharaj' and 'Sant Ravidas Maharaj' as per the instructions in Government of Maharashtra's GR under the guidance of Respected Principal Dr.Rajendra S. Zunjarrao Sir.

Debuji Zhingraji Janorkar, who is popularly known as Gadge Baba, was born in a small village Shengaon of district Amravati, Maharashtra, India on 23rd February 1876.

Principal Sir mentioned that Sant Gadge Baba was a great saint of 19th century and is known for his social services. Sant Gadge Maharaj was a mendicant-saint and social reformer from the Indian state of Maharashtra. He lived in voluntary poverty and wandered to different villages promoting social justice and initiating reforms, especially related to sanitation. He was a holy saint who worked for helpless and poor. Community-service became the base of his teachings of Baba.

Sant Gadge Baba's teachings were:

- 1. Give food to the hungry.
- 2. Give shelter to the needy.
- 3. Protect the environment.

Principal Sir also mentioned that Sant Ravidasji was an Indian mystic poet-sant of the Bhakti movement and founder of Ravidassia religion during the 15th to 16th century CE. He was a guru (teacher) in the region of Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and mainly Punjab and Haryana. The Adi Granth of Sikhs, and Panchvani of the Hindu warrior-ascetic group Dadupanthis are the two oldest attested sources of the literary works of Ravidas. He was a poet-saint, social reformer and a spiritual figure. Ravidas's devotional Verses were included in the Sikh scriptures known as Guru Granth Sahib. The Panch Vani text of the Dadupanthi tradition within Hinduism also includes numerous poems of Ravidas. He taught removal of social divisions of caste and gender, and promoted unity in the pursuit of personal spiritual freedoms.

Under the guidance of Respected Principal Dr. Rajendra S. Zunjarrao Sir, Librarian Dr. Shantashree Sengupta, Library Staff and the students paid their respect to Sant Ravidas Maharaj.

Sir mentioned that Bhagat Singh together with his companions Rajguru, Sukhdev, Azad, and Gopal fought for the assassination of Lala Lajpat Rai. Bhagat Singh became an inspiration for youngsters due to his daring adventures. He with his companions on 8th April, 1929 threw bombs over the Central Legislative Assembly by reading the slogan "Inquillab Zindabad". And for this, a murder case was charged against them. On 23rd March, 1931 in the Lahore Jail they were hanged. Their body was cremated at the banks of the Sutlej River.


### 1.Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jayanti: 11th April 2022

Many of the development programs started by him have continued to work efficiently after his death. Tukdoji Maharaj once attended a World Religions and World Peace Conference in Japan.

Saint Tukdoji Maharaj performed rigorous penance and spiritual exercises in self-realisation. He also was a great orator and a musician who composed more than 3000 bhajans (spiritual poems) in Hindi and Marathi, having performed for the spiritual teacher Meher Baba in 1937 and 1944. He has also written many articles on Dharma, society, nation and education. He studied the existing religious sects and other schools of thought and discussed religious and secular problems of the devotees. He was determined to re-define socio-Spirituality and revitalise and awaken the nation. Saint Tukdoji Maharaj worked immensely for the Status of Women in Society. In 2005, the Nagpur University was renamed to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. Under the guidance of Respected Principal Dr. Rajendra S. ### 1.Mahatma Basweshwar Jayanti: 03rd May 2022

Under the guidance of Respected Principal Dr.Rajendra S. Zunjarrao Sir, Vice-Principal Faculty of Arts and Head, Department of Psychology Prof. Dr. Amruta Oke Madam, Librarian Dr. Shantashree Sengupta and Library Staff paid their respect to Mahatma Basweshwar.

Oke Madan mentioned that Mahatma Basveshwar Maharaj was an Indian 12th-century statesman, philosopher, poet, social reformer and Lingayat saint in the Shiva-focussed Bhakti movement, and Hindu Shaivite social reformer during the reign of the Kalyani Chalukya/Kalachuri dynasty. Mahatma Basveshwar spread social awareness through his poetry, popularly known as Vachanaas. He rejected gender or social discrimination, superstitions and rituals but introduced Ishtalinga necklace, with an image of the Shiva Linga to every person regardless of his or her birth, to be a constant reminder of one's bhakti (devotion) to Shiva. As the Chief Minister of his kingdom, he introduced new public institutions such as the Anubhava Mantapa (or, the "hall of spiritual experience"), which welcomed men and women from all socio-economic backgrounds to discuss spiritual and mundane questions of life, in open. He is also known as Bhaktibhandari (literally, the treasurer of devotion), Basavanna. The community he helped form is also known as the Sharanas. Basava taught that every human being was equal, irrespective of caste, and that all forms of manual labor was equally important.

### 2.National Anti-terrorism Day (दहशतवाद व हिंसाचार विरोधी दिवस): 21st May 2022




### 3.Maharana Pratap Singh Jayanti: 25th May 2022





He installed gymnasiums and wrestling pitches and highlighted the importance of health consciousness among the youth.
