## Best Student Trophy Contest Academic Year 2020-21

The important value addition in the process of selection of Best Student Trophy winner:

- The discussion to develop the new marking system and to call external reviewer to interview the students was held in the meeting of Best Student Trophy (9<sup>th</sup> February 2021). It was decided to reform the marking scheme and introduce the third round as 'External Reviewer Round'.
- The selection process is categorized in three rounds
  - o **First Round-Screening Round:** Scrutinizing the applications with documents and calculation of credit points. Five students from each wing will be shortlisted for the second round on the basis of credit points.
  - Second Round-Personal Interview and Group Discussion Round: Shortlisted students will be interviewed along with Group discussion by the panel of judges for each wing. Three students will be shortlisted on the basis of credit points received in the second round.
  - Third Round-External Reviewer Round:
    The shortlisted students from the second round will be interviewed by the external reviewer.
- The new marking system is developed by Prof. Pooja M. Paratane and Prof. Pratul V. Gadagkar. According to this new marking module, the best student from each wing will be declared on the basis of his/her performance in all three rounds.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic situation, it was not possible to conduct the Best Student Trophy Contest on offline mode. Committee accepted the challenge and successfully conducted all rounds of the Best Student Trophy Contest: Second Round and Third Round for each wing completely on online mode for all wings smoothly without any interruption.

The felicitation program of all contestants and winners could not be organized due to COVID-19 pandemic situation. So committee organized online 'Kautuk Sohala' to congratulate all. Parents of students are also invited for the online program. Parents appreciated the efforts of committee and college taken to organize such programs in their feedback. Principal Dr. R.S. Zunjarrao guided to all students on this occasion.
