



B. B. A. PROGRAMME

Introduction :

BBA is a full time 3 year programme leading to the award of Bachelor's degree in Business Administration by the Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) with academic autonomy.

The learning methodology includes lectures, assignments, industrial visits & project work; etc. The course imparts knowledge, develops specialized skills and fosters an attitude essential for the growth of the students to become responsible and successful business managers in today's competitive business world.



Course Structure :

A student shall be evaluated for a total of 4400 marks divided into 1600 marks per academic year. Continuous Internal

Evaluation will be of 40 marks mainly consisting of Experiential Learning, Online Test, Internal Examination, day to day class performance and attendance. Each subject carries 3 credit points whereas tutorial and project carries 2 credit points. For FY BBA (Autonomous), SY BBA (Autonomous) and TY BBA (Autonomous) there will be CIE I, II, III of 40 Marks and the

End Sem Examination of 60 Marks (2hours duration). The class will be awarded to the student on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by him/her for all three years.

Objectives of BBA Programme:

- To provide a proper understanding of subjects in management.
- To prepare the students to face the competition & grab opportunities in the field of management.
- To train students in soft skills.
- To provide opportunity to the students to attain practical experience by doing various extra curricular activities.

Eligibility:

AVacant seats will be filled in through the entrance test conducted by the college. Selection will be based on merit and reservations as per the rules of Savitribai Phule Pune University. Following are the eligibility details:

(i) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Degree course in Bachelor of Business Administration shall have passed 12th Std. Examination (H.S.C. 10+2) from any stream with English as passing subject and has secured 40% marks at 12th Std.
(ii) Two years Diploma in Pharmacy after H.S.C., Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or

its equivalent.

(iii) Three Year Diploma Course (after H.S.C., i.e. 10th Standard) of Board of Technical Education conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent.

(iv) MCVC

(v) Every eligible candidate has to pass a Common Entrance Test to be conducted by the respective Institute / College.

Admission Procedure:

Admission will be on the basis of HSC merit and as per Maharashtra Government rule.

Rules for attendance:

Every student is expected to have 100% attendance (min 75% attendance is compulsory). All the students are also expected to participate actively in the seminars and extra curricular activities organized by the college, in their interest.

B. B. A. (C.A.) PROGRAMME

Introduction:

BBA (CA) is an autonomous 3 years full time professional credit based course designed to bridge the gap between the industry and the academia. The program offers courses which are a blend of computer applications, management and commerce. This course aims at inculcating essential skills as demanded by the global software industry through interactive learning process. BBA (CA) course is meant to heighten technological know-how, to train students to become industry specialists, to provide research-based training and to encourage software development.



Course Structure :

The BBA (CA) Program is of a Three Year

(Six semesters) Full Time Degree Program having credit system comprising 132 credits. Each subject will be of 3 credits. Each practical or project will be of 2 credits.

Objectives of BBA(CA) Programme:

- To provide conceptual grounding in computer usage as well as its practical business application.
- To prepare the students to face the competition & grab opportunities in the industry.
- To train students in soft skills.
- To provide an opportunity to the students to attain practical experience by doing various extra curricular activities.

Eligibility:

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course in BBA (Computer Application) shall have passed 12th std examination (H.S.C 10+2) from any stream with English as a passing subject with 40% marks at 12th std. Relaxation of 5% of marks for reserved category students.

Or

Two years Diploma in Pharmacy after H. S. C., Board of Technical Education, conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent.

Or

Three years Diploma Course after S.S.C., Board

of Technical Education, conducted by Government of Maharashtra or its equivalent.

Admission Procedure:

Admission will be on the basis of HSC merit and as per Maharashtra Government rule.

Rules for attendance:

Every student is expected to have 100% attendance (min. 75% attendance is compulsory). All the Students are also expected to participate actively in the seminars and extra curricular activities organized by the college, in their interest.



B. B. A. (IB) PROGRAMME

Introduction:

Bachelor of Business Administration in International Business [BBA-IB] it is a 3years graduation course having 6 semesters under the Savitribai Phule Pune University with academic autonomy. The course teaches the students to impart higher level concepts in the domain of International Business and foreign trade. The program is designed to give a broad knowledge of functional aspects related to logistic management, export houses, dry ports, STC etc. The degree also helps in learning foreign languages such as French, German, and Spanish etc. Core subjects



who are related to course allow the students to specialize in a specific academic area.

Course Structure : FYBBA(IB), SYBBA (IB) and TYBBA (IB)

In autonomous structure, we have credit based evaluation. The total course is of 132 credits.

The examination pattern consists of Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester Evaluation.

A student is evaluated internally for 40 marks (consisting of CIE I, II and III). The End Semester Examination is of 60 Marks. The Continuous Internal Assessment has variety of activities that, student will be performing. First CIE is of 10 marks, which is based on field report writing, second CIE, which is also of 10 marks, consist of on line examination, and third CIE is of 20 marks, which is a written examination.

- To impart global exposure to the students by developing business skills, entrepreneurial and managerial skills
- To develop soft skills and ethical values for adjusting under global scenario
- To provide learning of European and Asian languages for global outreach
- To enhance employability of the students by providing Industrial exposure in the form of study visits, guest lectures and Internships
- To give an understanding of the global market through Experiential learning

M.Com

Introduction:

M.Com is a full time 2 year programme leading to the award of Masters Degree in Commerce by the Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) with academic autonomy.

Objectives:

- a. To offer quality education in field of commerce at higher level.
- b. To equip and train students for seeking professional careers in field of Accountancy and Cost & Management Accountancy and accepting the challenges of changing Business World.
- c. To develop independent logical thinking and facilitate personality development of students to cater to the manpower needs of industries in Accounting, Taxation, Auditing and Financial Analysis & Management.
- d. To enable students for seeking career as Entrepreneur by developing communication and analytical skills.
- e. To prepare students for Data collection by various methods and their interpretations.

Duration & Structure of course :

The M.Com. Course will be of two years duration consisting of two parts. i.e. Part I and Part II. Each part is having two semesters. Thus the M.Com. Course is of four semesters. For each Semester there will be four papers of 100 marks each. The M.Com. Degree will be of 1600 marks in aggregate.

Eligibility:

The student who has passed any Bachelors degree of Savitribai Phule Pune University or any other recognized University shall be held eligible to be admitted to M.Com. Course.

Evaluation Pattern:

The examination of M.Com. Course shall be based on Semester Examination, Continuous Assessment, Choice Based Credit

System, and Semester Grade Point Average and Cumulative Grade Point Average System. In each Semester, there will 50 marks for Internal Assessment (attendance, home assignments, class tests, classroom presentation and Mid Semester Examination) and 50 marks for Semester End Examination for each paper of 100 marks.

Students are required to secure the additional 16 credit points which are compulsory in nature for additional subjects; Human Rights, Cyber Security, Skill Development, Internship and Field Work (Part I & Part II)

Students are required to secure the additional 10 credit points which are compulsory in nature for additional subjects; Human Rights, Cyber Security, Skill Development, Internship and Field Work.

Guideline Book 2021-2022

CODE OF CONDUCT

Maintenance of Discipline and Good Conduct by Students

(Under Section 87 & Section 39(III) of Savitribai Phule Pune University Act, 1974)

- 1. Every student of Modern College shall at all times:
- (i) Conduct himself properly
- (ii) Maintain proper behavior
- (iii) Observe strict discipline both on the campus of the college and also outside, in buses, trains or at public places or at picnics or educational trips arranged by the college or at play-grounds
- (iv) Ensure that no act of his/her consciously or unconsciously brings the college into dispute.
- (v) Shall not lodge any complaint or make any representation regarding any matter connected with college to the press or other outside institution/agency etc. without forwarding the same through the Principal of the college.
- 2. Any act of the student which is contrary to the provisions of clause (1) shall constitute misconduct and/or indiscipline which terms shall mean and include, among other, any one or more of the acts jointly or serverally, mentioned hereinafter, namely
- (i) any act that directly or indirectly causes or attempts to cause disturbance in the lawful functioning of the college.
- (ii) Habitual unpunctuality in attending lectures, practicals, tutorials, and other courses as may be prescribed.
- (iii) Repeated absence from lectures, tutorials practicals and other courses as prescribed
- (iv) Canvassing for or accepting contributions or otherwise associating himself or herself with raising of any fund or any object whatever without the

previous sanction of the Principal

- (v) Securing admission in the college to a post-graduate programme or any other course by fabrication or super session of fact or information
- (vi) Obstruction to any student or group of students in his or their legitimate activities, whether in the classroom, laboratories, fields, playgrounds, gymnasium or places of social and cultural activity within the campus of the college.
- (vii) Possessing or using firearms, lethal weapons, explosives, or dangerous or corrosive substance on the premises of the college.
- (viii) Possessing or consuming any poisonous or stupefying drug or intoxicant in any form in the college
- (ix) Ragging, bullying or harassing any student in college or outside thereof
- (x) Indulging in any act as would cause annoyance or embarrassment to any other student, or member of the authorities of the college or to staff member, or any member of the family of the staff.
- (Xii) Destroying or attempting to destroy or tamper with any official record or document of the college.
- (Xiii) Conduct unbecoming of the student at any meeting or special functions or sports and cultural activities arranged by the college or at any other public place
- (Xiv) Stealing or damaging for any property belonging to the college, staff member of the college or any other student
- (Xv) Instigating violence or participating in any violent demonstrations or violent agitation or violent strike in the college
- (Xvi) Students are responsible for their belongings.


