STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2023-24

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted along with the process of obtaining feedback from the students. The form for student satisfaction survey was made available on the Login ID of each student using the ERP 'Vriddhi' during the academic year 2023-24. Responses were taken from the students on overall working of the college and more particularly on following aspects, on a five-point scale:

- a) Facilities provided by the college to students
- b) Curriculum Implementation and Examination system adopted by the college
- a) In case of the facilities provided by the College, the level of satisfaction of the students with respect to 22 parameters listed below was known from responses on a five-point scale viz. 'Very Satisfied', 'Satisfied', 'Satisfied only to some extent', 'Neither Satisfied nor dissatisfied (or Neutral)' and 'Not satisfied'.

Benchmark: On the designed five-point scale, the acceptable range of responses is as follows: For level of satisfaction, aggregate maximum responses should be received for the options 'Very Satisfied', 'Satisfied' and 'Satisfied only to some extent'.
