- **Qualification required for eligibility:**
 1. B.Sc. (second class) with Statistics principal and Mathematics at subsidiary level.
 2. B.Sc. (second class) with Mathematics principal and Statistics at subsidiary level.
 3. M.Sc. (second class) in Mathematics.

4. **B.Sc. (second class) in Actuarial Science with Mathematics and Statistics at subsidiary level.**
5. **B.Sc. (second class) with three subject at third year with Statistics as one of the subjects.**

Cancellation of admission norms are as follows:

Sr. No	Percentage of refund of fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the institute
